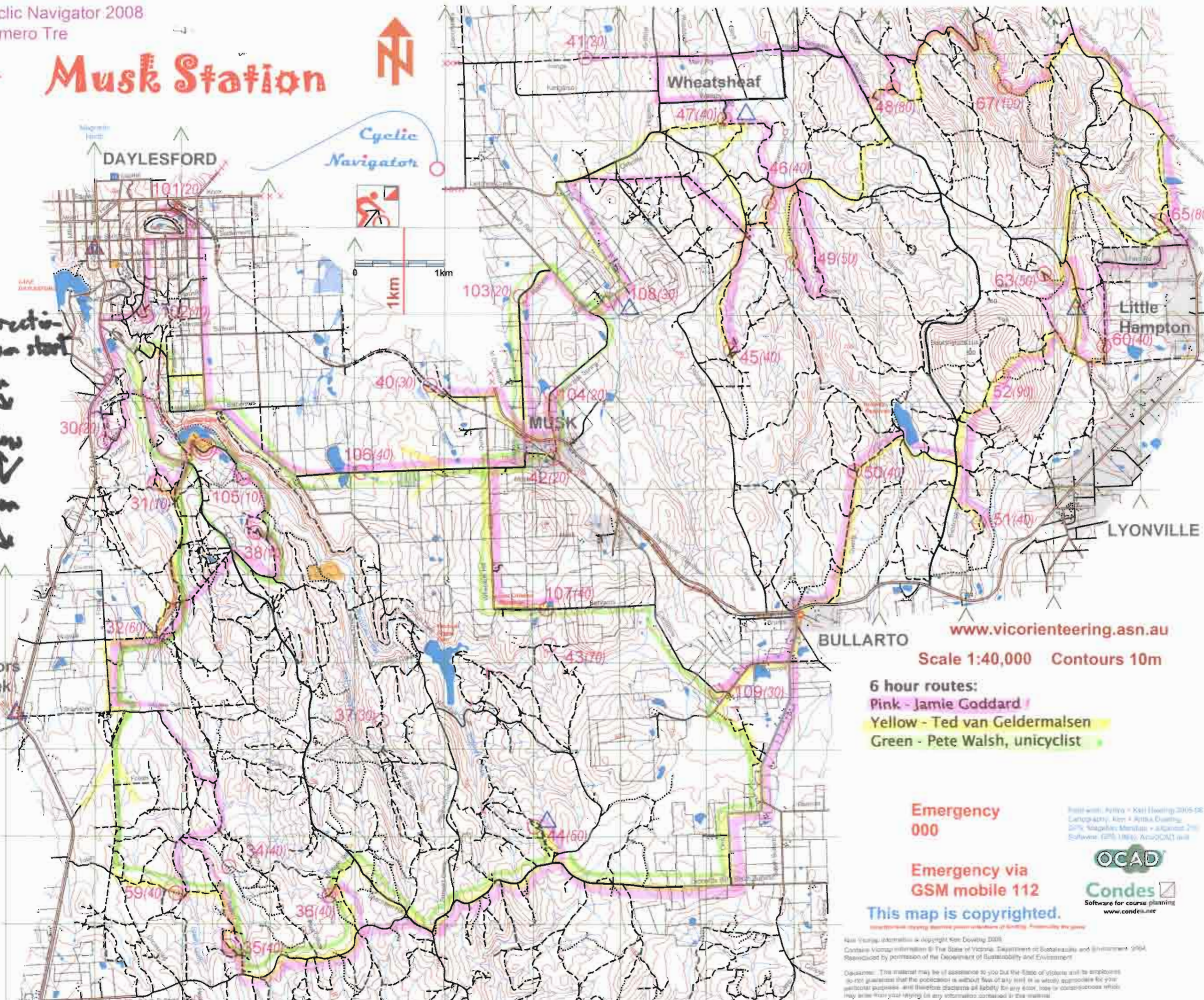

Bush Fire Safety

You must NOT get caught outdoors.
Leave the area immediately if safe to do so
OR seek refuge in an enclosed building.

- If no other choice:
- seek refuge behind rocky outcrop or high wall in cave, gully or large animal burrow, in large area away from trees and grass, in large dam or lake
 - avoid slopes and hill tops - avoid being above
 - do NOT seek refuge in above ground tanks
 - cover exposed skin with dry natural fibre cloth
